Situation

- There continues to be 11 confirmed states of local emergency; High River remains under a provincial state of emergency.
- Alberta Provincial Operations Centre reports that approximately 1600 evacuees in Calgary will require interim housing due to flood damage.
- Interim housing is being constructed for approximately 275 displaced residents of High River.
- Major transportation corridors are starting to open; major sections continue to remain closed.


CRC Response

- Over 35,000 people have been registered through call centres and self-registration online.
- Canadian Red Cross distributed 25,000 relief supplies to nearly 16,000 residents (clean up kits, first aid kit, hygiene items, water, towels, cots and blankets) as part of a mass distribution effort to flood-affected communities in Alberta
- CRC relief and early recovery operations continue in Stoney Nation, Siksika and Tsuu T'ina
- 48 Red Cross volunteers assisted with the distribution of Government of Alberta debit cards in four locations in Calgary yesterday. Distribution continues today.
- CRC continues to support management of shelters in Calgary for 159 evacuees. Four other shelters are being support with material resources.

Outlook

- Re-entry for section 3 of High River is planned for 03 July 2013. CRC will assist with bulk distribution to approximately 4,000 residents.
- Service delivery planning has commenced for extended relief, early recovery and long term recovery.








